

There's truth in Texas blues, and this collection gives us smooth, old-fashioned sentiment from a lonesome soul. The 20 tracks were recorded over 1950 and '51, one of the most generative periods for Hopkins, who either plays solo or with bassist Donald Cooks.

4. Muddy Waters, Johnny Winter & James Cotton: *Breakin' it Up, Breakin' it Down*

Recorded live, and almost lost, these 11 tracks were released 30 years after their performance on the 1977 *Hard Again* tour.

5. Howlin' Wolf: Howlin' Wolf/Moanin' in the Moonlight

Blazing guitar, subterranean growl, and thunderous electricity – this 2 CD set combines Howlin' Wolf's first self-titled album as well as his second release, *Moanin' in the Moonlight*.
