Thanks to increased participation from New members and also Sustaining members, the goal for *Celebration 2015* is \$978,000 -- \$20,000 less than the fall!

Celebration 2015 is scheduled to begin Tuesday, October 13. Shifts are 2-3 hours long and are scheduled throughout each day of the drive from 6:00 AM to 10:00 PM.

Volunteers take pledges over the phone and interact with HPR supporters across the state. Group size can range from 4 to 20 people depending on shift requirements.
